Organization
 of Court
 and Grand
 Jury.

Be it remembered that at a
 regular Term of the Circuit Court of Baldwin County
 Alabama, begun and held at the said Court House
 of said County, on the fourth Monday of October
 A.D. 1910, the same being the 24th day of said
 month, Honor Samuel B Brown Judge Presiding
 and also were present the Clerk of said Court and
 the Sheriff of said County. Previous to the adjournment
 of the last term of this Court, to wit: on the
 7th day of April A.D. 1910, the Judge of this Court
 drew from the Jury box in open Court fifty cards on
 each of which was a name to supply the Grand
 Jury for this term and the petit jurors for the
 first week, and the names of the persons drawn
 are: Jesse E Wilson, John M Bishop, Noah Wilcox
 Lucie H Rogers, Sam Martin, George W Miller,

H Lee Perry, Allen C Grimes, Chas P Hanson, G Ed Burgett, Jay B M^c Grew, And the Judge placed them in an envelope sealed same, and on the 5th day of October 1910 delivered them to the Clerk of the Court, who forth with issued to the Sheriff a venire facias containing the names of the persons drawn the day they are to appear, their Occupation, and the place of business and residence. And now comes Thos A Booth, Sheriff of said County, and returns into Court, his venire facias served upon all of said jurors, except Noah Sisco & Lee Perry, G Ed Burgett, and Lealie H Bygones, all of whom answered to their names except James C Stapleton, John B Shipp Sam Runkles, Arthur Nixon, and it appearing to the Court that said persons have a good and sufficient excuse for their non attendance at this term of the Court it is ordered that they be and are excused and the following of said persons so drawn and summoned viz: Henry Eison, Jesse Batson, John Pettman Jr, Wm L Barnett, Roscoe Chisler appeared and in open Court submitted reasons why they should not serve as jurors it is ordered that they be and are excused.

And now after hearing excuses, claims of exemptions and disqualifications and passing upon the same it appears to the Court that there are not enough qualified jurors in attendance upon the Court to form the juries required, the Judge of the Court drew from the jury box the names of the following jurors viz: George W Humphries, E Alonzo Huggins, Arthur Lruin, Herbert Killcrease, John Schumaker, Pete H Jones, John W Miller, James Thompson, John J Campbell, Benjamin L Britt, Arrie C Hall, Wm M Burns, James L Brown, Margaret Nixon, Wm P Matthews, Will Comarster, Willard W Olney, John who were then within or reside within five miles of the Court House. To complete juries, then required the Sheriff forthwith, to summon such jurors to attend Court instantly. And now on this the 24th day of October 1910 the Judge presiding in open Court required all the persons in attendance upon the Court named in the venire to be called and after hearing excuses claims of exemptions

and disqualifications and passing upon the same, caused to be placed in a hat the cards containing the names of all the persons present, who were not excused by the Court. An exempt or disqualified and the Judge first drew therefrom eighteen of said cards containing the following names, Ray P. Mix, Will J. Cronastie, Chas. P. Hanson, Allen R. Grimes, Christopher Columbus Rodgers, Robert L. Fulford, Jiles L. Phillips, James Hester Thassey, W. Dangleas Durant, Richard B. Baggett, Chas. F. Davison, J. E. Dyer, John W. Baggett, Ray Brewton, Wm. M. Burns, Jay B. McEwen, Orris L. Hall, and George W. Humphries, who compose the Grand Jury for this term and it appearing to the Court, that the Grand Jury is now complete and is composed of the said eighteen named Jurors, the Court appointed George W. Humphries as Foreman of the Grand Jury, and administered to him the oath as set forth in Section 7284 of the Criminal Code of Alabama, while the oath set forth in Section 7285 was duly administered to the other Grand Jurors, and M. H. McKinnis was sworn in as Bailiff in attendance to the Grand Jury, then organized, who being duly charged in reference to the business to be transacted by them retired to the Grand Jury Room,
