The Grand Jury of said County charge that, before the finding of this indictment, and since August 9th 1909, Jim Hayes, sold, offered for sale, or otherwise unlawful disposition, or otherwise disposed of prohibited liquors and beverages,

2. And the said Grand Jury further charge that before the finding of this indictment, and since August 26th 1909, Jim Hayes sold, offered for sale, kept for sale or otherwise unlawful disposition or otherwise disposed of prohibited liquors and beverages.

3 And the Grand Jury further charge that before the finding of this indictment and since August 9th 1909, Jim Hayes sold, offered for sale, or otherwise unlawful disposition, or otherwise disposed of spirituous, vinous, or malt liquors contrary to law.

4 And the Grand Jury further charge that, before the finding of this indictment, and since August 9th, 1909, Jim Hayes, maintained an unlawful drinking place, contrary to the statutes in such case made and provided.

5. And the Grand Jury further charge that before the finding of this indictment and since August 9th, 1909, Jim Hayes, carried on the business of a retail dealer in liquors, or of a retail dealer in malt liquors.
