

The State vs Julia Catlett assault and battery with a weapon

The State of Alabama

Baldwin County Circuit Court Fall Term 1910

Be it remembered that a regular term of the Circuit Court of Baldwin County Alabama, held at the said Court House of said County, on the ^{fourth} Monday of October A.D. 1910, the same being the 24th day of said month, His Honor Samuel B. Brown Judge presiding and also were present the Clerk of said Court, and the Sheriff of said County.

Previous to the adjournment of the last term of this Court, to wit: on the 7th day of April A.D. 1910, the Judge of this drew from the jury box, in open Court fifty cards on each of which was a name to supply the Grand Jury for this term and petit-juries for the first week, and the names of the persons drawn are: Jesse C. Nelson, John B. Bishop, Noah Silcox, Leslie H. Bryars, Sam Martin, George W. Miller, James T. Bradley, James C. Stapleton, Dan McParren, George H. Ware, Chas. G. Wilson, L. Richard Catlett, Henry Liskson, John B. Shipps, Wm. H. Chandler, Sam W. Stewart, Sam Arne, Arthur Nixon, James R. Hammett, William Lambert, J. Asse Batson, J. O. B. Johnson, Paul Rolfe.

W. Douglas Durant, Randolph McBowen, Joseph B. Brown, James Holton Deasley, John Pittman Jr, Wm. H. Bishop, Cleveland and Geo. Wm. L. Barnette, Percy Clibbe, John C. Gorden, Frank Redmond, Chas. Phillips, John W. Lawer, Robert L. Guilford, Harrison Stoumley, John W. Baggett, J. O. Dease, Chas. T. Davison, Richard B. Baggett, J. Lee L. Phillips, H. Lee Perry, Allen C. Krimes, Chas. P. Hanson, H. Ed. Burgett, Jay B. McNew, and

the Judge placed them in an envelope and sealed same, and on the 5th day of October 1910 delivered them to the Clerk of the Court, who forthwith issued to the Sheriff a writ of facias containing the names of the persons drawn the day they are to appear, their occupation, and the place of business and residence. And now comes Thos. A. Booth.

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Sheriff of said County and returns into Court his venire facias served upon all of said jurors, except Wm H. Silcox, H. Lee Perry, G. Ed. Burgett and Leslie H. Bryans, all of whom answered to their names, except James C. Stapleton, John B. Shipp, Sam. Leane, Arthur Nixon. And it appearing to the Court that said persons have a good and sufficient excuse for their nonattendance, at this term of the Court it is ordered that they be and are excused, and the following of said persons so drawn and summoned viz: Henry Gipson, J. Assee Batson, John Pittman Jr, Wm L. Barnette, Roscoe Cligbe, appeared and in open Court, submitted reasons why they should not serve as jurors it is ordered that they be and are excused. And now after hearing excuses, claims of exemptions and disqualifications and passing upon the same it appears to the Court, that there are not enough qualified jurors in attendance upon the Court to form the juries required the Judge of the Court, drew from the jury box the names of the following jurors viz: George W. Humphries, Calousa Steggins, Cathus Drwin, Herbert Killecrease, John Schumaker, Peter H. Jones, John W. Miller, James M. Thompson, John H. Campbell, Benjamin C. Brill, Carrie H. Hall, Amy M. Gurne, James L. Brown, Morgan Nixon, Am. Mathews, Bill Leomartie, Willard W. Orney, J. R. Mix, who were then with in or resided within five miles of the Court House, to complete all juries, then required the Sheriff forthwith to summon such jurors to attend Court instantly. And now on this 24th day of October 1910, the Judge presiding in open Court, required all the persons in attendance upon the Court named in the venire to be called. And after hearing excuses claims of exemptions and disqualifications, and passing upon the same caused to be placed in a hat the cards containing the names of all the persons

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present, who were not excused by the Court, or exempt or disqualified and the Judge first drew there from eighteen of said Cards containing the following names, Jay P. Mix, Lucie J. Leonard, Chas. P. Hanson, Allen B. Grimes, Christopher Columbus Rodgers, Robert L. Dieford, Giles L. Phillips, James Holton, Beasley, W. Douglas Durant, Richard B. Baggett, Chas. H. Davison, Joe Dyer, John W. Baggett, Ray Brewton, J. M. Burns, Jay B. McKnew, Willie C. Hall, and George W. Humphries, who compose the Grand Jury for this term, and it appearing to this Court, that the Grand Jury is now complete and is composed of the said eighteen named Jurors, the Court appointed George W. Humphries as foreman of the Grand Jury and administered to him the oath as set forth in section 7284 the Criminal Code of Alabama. While the oath set forth in section 7285 was duly administered to the other Grand Jurors, and W. H. Wilkins was sworn in as Bailiff in attendance to the Grand Jury, then organized, who being duly charged in reference to the business to be transacted by them, retired to the Grand Jury Room.

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Indictment

The Grand Jury of said County, Charge that, before the finding of this Indictment, Julia Catlett assaulted and beat Argilla Burkett with a stick. And said Grand Jury further Charge that, before the finding of this Indictment, Julia Catlett assaulted and beat Argilla Burkett -

Against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
