

The State vs Maria Bibbo Murder, continued

Arthur Nixon, and it appearing to the Court, that said persons have a good and sufficient excuse for their non attendance, at this term of the Court - it is ordered that they be and are excused. And the following of said persons so drawn and summoned by Henry Simpson, Pleaser, Watson, John Pittman, and L. Barnette, Rose Elize, appeared and in open Court submitted reasons why they should not serve as jurors, it is ordered that they be and are hereby excused. And now after hearing excuses, claims of exemption and disqualifications, and passing upon the same it appears to the Court that there are not enough qualified jurors in attendance upon the Court to form the juries required, the Judge of the Court drew from the jury box the names of the following jurors by: George W. Humphries, Eltona Higgins, Arthur Driscoll, Herbert Kilcrease, John Schumaker, Pete H. Jones, John Whiller, James M. Thompson, John Campbell, Benjamin L. Britt, Ozie C. Hall, Ben M. Burns, James L. Brown, Muggan Nixon, and P. Mathews, Will Cronartie, William L. Orney, J. P. Mix, who were then within, or resided within five miles of the Court House, to complete all juries. Then required the Sheriff, Jathurth to summon such jurors to attend Court instant, And now on this 24th of October 1910, the Judge presiding in open Court required all the persons in attendance upon the Court, named in the venire to be called and after hearing excuses, claims of exemption and disqualification, and passing upon the same, caused to be placed in a hat the cards containing the names of all the persons present, who were not excused by the Court, or exempt or disqualified. And the Judge first drew therefrom eighteen of said cards containing the following names, Jay P. Mix, Will Cronartie, Chas P. Harmon,

Allen C. Grimes, Christopher Columbus Rodgers, Robert L. Puleford, Giles B. Phillips, James Holton, Beaslee, W. Douglas Durant, Richard B. Baggett, Chas. H. Davison, Joe Duss, John W. Baggett, Ray Brewster, Junius B. Bunn, Jay B. McKee, Ariel Hall, and George W. Humphries, who compose the Grand Jury for this term, and it appears to this Court, that the Grand Jury is now complete and is composed of the said eighteen named jurors; the Court appointed George W. Humphries as foreman of the Grand Jury and administered to him the oath as set forth in section 7284 of the Criminal Code of Alabama, while the oath set forth in section 7285 was duly administered to the other Grand Jurors, thus organized, who being duly charged in reference to the business to be transacted by them retired to the Grand Jury Room.

James C. Stapleton, Peter G. Dahl, Saml. Calkins
Jerome Seay, and Joseph Mc Gill, in open Court,
submitted reasons why they should not serve
as Jurors, at the present term of this Court, and
asked the Court to excuse them, which upon
consideration it is ordered by the Court that
they be and are excused, James C. Stapleton
being permanently excused. Thereupon after
hearing all excuses and claims of exemption
and disqualifications, and passing upon
all of the excuses or claims. The Judge presiding
in open Court caused the names of all the Jurors
in attendance upon the Court, who were not
excused by the Court, to be written upon sep-
arate slips or cards and placed in a hat or
box. And thereupon the Judge of the Court did
in open Court, draw from the hat or box the
names of eighteen Jurors who were then due
and legally empanelled, sworn and chan-
ged by the Court as the Grand Jury, for the
present term of the Court, as follows to wit:

sworn by the Court as Foreman of said
