Comes your Complainant, Emma Jessie Woods, and humbly
complaining against the Respondent, Lonnie L. Woods, respectfully
represents and shows unto your Honor and this Honorable Court as
follows:

1. That Your Complainant and the Respondent are both
over twenty-one years of age and residents of Robertsdale, in
Baldwin County, Alabama.

2. That your Complainant and the Respondent were married
at Union Springs, Alabama, on, to-wit: March 21st, 1936, and
lived together as husband and wife until November 26th, 1938.

3. That the Respondent is a man of ungovernable temper;
that on to-wit: November 26th, 1938, and various times prior
thereto, the Respondent has cursed, abused and threatened the
Complainant; that on November 26th, 1938, he did actual violence
to her person by striking and ~~choking~~ her; that his conduct is
such that Complainant has every reasonable apprehension to believe,

4. That there were no children born to your Complainant

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, Complainant prays
that your Honor will, by proper process, make the said Lonnie L.
Woods, party respondent to this Bill of Complaint, requiring him
to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under
the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable
Court.

Complainant further prays that upon a final hearing of
this cause, this Honorable Court will give and grant unto her a
decree of absolute divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony

existing between her and the Respondent, Lonnie L. Woods; that your Honor will give and grant unto her such other, further, different and/or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive, and as in duty bound she will ever pray.
