His conduct was such, and it growing worse from time to time, until it became absolutely impossible for me to live with him. The conduct of the Respondent was such as to cause me to have every reasonable apprehension to believe, and I did actually believe that if I continued to live with him, he would continue to abuse me and do further violence to my person, which would necessarily endanger my life and health. On various occasions he has actually beaten me with his fist, and just because our child would cry, he would mistreat and whip and beat her.

Our child, June Davis, has been right with me all of her life and I have had to care and support her. Her father has contributed very little toward her support. In fact, about the only thing he ever did for her was to buy her small articles of clothing.

The Respondent has no property and no place that he can call home. He is a barber by trade and moves about from place to place where he can find work.

While I have never personally seen Bufford Davis strike my daughter, she has often told me and her mother that he was abusing and threatening her and that on various occasions had actually struck her.

I know that Bufford Davis has contributed very little toward the support and maintenance of Trene and their child. I remember on one occasion Trene complained that Bufford had struck her and showed a scar on her lip.

I know that Bufford Davis is not a suitable person for my daughter to live with, nor is he a proper person to have thecare and custody of their minor child.
