DECREE.

This cause coming on to be heard is submitted for Decree upon the Petition of Alexandra Tampary and the ex-parte affidavits of R. Wood and J. D. Papadeas, and upon consideration thereof it is ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the court that Theodore Tampary, a minor who is over the age of eighteen, be, and he is hereby, relieved of the disabilities of non-age, and he is vested with the power to sue and be sued, contract and to be contracted with, to receive and take possession of real and personal property to which he is entitled; to purchase real or personal estate, to sell and to convey, and to do all things, and to all intents and purposes as effectually as if he were twenty-one years of age.

It is further decreed that the said Theodore Tampary pay the costs of this proceedings, for which execution may issue.
