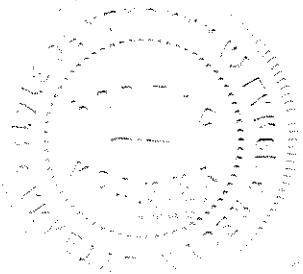


Dear Mrs. Blackmon:
