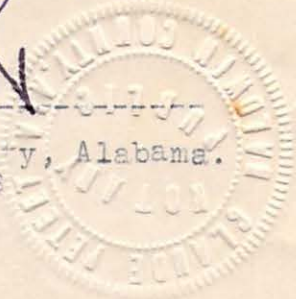

This cause coming on to be heard was submitted upon Bill of Complaint, Decree Pro Confesso on PUBLICATION

and Testimony as noted by the Register, and upon consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in said bill.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be, and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the said

DANIEL CLEMENTS

is forever divorced from the said LULA CLEMENTS

for and on account of VOLUNTARY ABANDONMENT.

It is further ordered, that DANIEL CLEMENTS be, and HE hereby is permitted to marry again after this Decree becomes absolute, but upon condition precedent that the costs of this suit are first paid. This Decree is made against said Defendant without personal service and is not absolute for twelve months from the rendition thereof, and the Defendant may file a petition showing sufficient cause for setting aside this Decree and permitting her to defend the suit on its merits at any time within twelve months unless she has been served with a copy of this Decree, when said petition must be filed within six months from said service. The Register is directed to send a copy of this Decree to the Defendant if her residence can be ascertained.

It is further ordered that DANIEL CLEMENTS the COMPLAINANT pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.
