COMPLAINT

COUNT ONE

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendants the sum of TWENTY FIVE THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$25,000.00) DOLLARS, for the breach of an agreement entered into by them on, to-wit, the 1st day of June, 1971, in substance as follows: Rudolph C. Rolison agreed to manage and operate a business, called Panel Mart, engaged primarily in its initial stage in the selling of panelling at a site to be selected and agreed upon by all of the parties. Henry H. Sully, Jr. agreed to put up the sum of \$10,000.00 for initial capital investment. Jack E. Pope agreed to put up the sum of \$10,000.00 for initial capital investment. The business was to be operated as a partnership initially with Plaintiff and Defendants being equal partners. It was further agreed that all profits would be divided as follows.

- (1) Rudolph C. Rolison to get the 1st \$700.00 per month out of net profits with this money to be treated as a salary.
- (2) Net profits over \$700.00 and up to \$2,100.00 to be divided equally between Henry H. Sully, Jr. and Jack E. Pope.
- (3) All net profits over \$2,100.00 to be divided equally between the Plaintiff and each of the Defendants.

It was further agreed that if the business were sold Henry H. Sully, Jr. and Jack E. Pope would each get back

their \$10,000.00 investment and any amounts in excess of \$20,000.00 would be divided equally between the partners.

It was further agreed that the business would be incorporated with Rudolph C. Rolison as its Vice President and owning shares of stock representing his interests in said business.

It was further agreed that a petty cash fund of between \$500.00 and \$2,000.00 was to be maintained with Rudolph C. Rolison having the power to write checks on this account.

It was further agreed that if one of the parties wanted to sell the others would have the option of purchasing his interest in said business and that as long as a party remained a partner he would not deal in anything that would conflict with the said company's operation.

It was further agreed that all promotionals and new stores would be handled through the Mobile office of Panel Mart.

And the Plaintiff says that, although he has complied with all its provisions on his part, the Defendants have failed to comply with the following provisions thereof, viz:

The Defendants incorporated a business using the name Panel Mart in which Plaintiff was not given any stock to reflect his interest in said business; funds generated by Plaintiff were used to pay expenses of the Defendants' corporation; the Defendants have refused to account to Plaintiff for the profits of the business, and have failed to set up a petty cash fund for said business.

Plaintiff further avers that as a direct and proximate result of the conduct of the Defendants he has been prevented from enjoying the fruits of his labors, and been deprived of his equity in said business, all to his great damages in the sum aforesaid, and Plaintiff claims special and general damages, hence this suit.

COUNT TWO

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendants TWENTY FIVE THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$25,000.00) DOLLARS, as damages for the conversion by them on, to-wit, the 28 day of April, 1972, of the following chattels:

666 Shares of stock in Panel Mart, Inc. the property of the Plaintiff.

COUNT THREE

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the following personal property, viz:

666 Shares of stock of Panel Mart, Inc. with the value of the hire or use thereof during the detention, viz: from, to-wit, the 28th day of April, 1972.




