Know All Men by These Presents, That we, the undersigned are held and firmly bound unto IDELL FRANKLIN CAMPBELL in the sum of \$670.40 SIX HUNDRED SEVENTY & 40/100 DOLLARS, to be paid to the said IDELL FRANKLIN CAMPBELL, heirs, executors, administrators or assigns; for which payment, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, and each of us, our and each of our heirs, executors, and administrators, jointly, severally, and firmly by these presents.

Sealed with our seals, and dated this 12th day of May 1954.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that, whereas, the above bound DORA ALLEN has commenced suit in the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, by summons and complaint returnable to the next term of said Court, to recover of said IDELL FRANKLIN CAMPBELL, the sum of \$335.20, THREE HUNDRED THIRTY FIVE & 20/100 DOLLARS, and has, on the day of the date hereof, prayed that writ of garnishment issue to CENTRAL BALDWIN BANK to answer on oath whether at the time of the service of said writ of garnishment or at the time of making its answer it has in its possession, or under its control any money or effects belonging to the defendant, IDELL FRANKLIN CAMPBELL and whether it is indebted to said defendant, or is liable to IDELL FRANKLIN CAMPBELL on any contract for the payment of money or the delivery of personal property, or on a contract for the payment of money which may be discharged by the delivery of personal property or which is payable in personal property, and said plaintiff having made affidavit as required by law in such cases and by entering into this bond, has obtained the same, returnable to the next term of Circuit Court of Baldwin County.
