Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of, to-wit, THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO AND 28/100 (#382.28) DOLLARS, damages, for the breach of a written agreement entered into by the Defendant on, to-wit, the 5th day of September, 1953, whereby the Defendant promised to pay to the Plaintiff the sum of FOUR HUNDRED AIGHTY-SEVEN AND 86/100 (\$487.86) DOLLARS, payable as follows: Thirtyfive and no/100 (\$35.00) Dollars on the 5th day of October, 1953, and the sum of Thirty-five and no/100 (\$35.00) Dollars on the 5th day of each successive month thereafter up to and including the 5th day of August, 1954, and a final payment of ONE HUNDRED TWO AND 86/100 (\$102.86) DOLLARS on the 5th day of September, 1954; for the purchase of an automobile.
