The condition of the above obligation is such, That whereas the above bound BROOKS MOTORS, on the day of the date hereof hath obtained at the suit of BOB BROOKS and BILL BROOKS doing business as BROOKS MOTORS vs: WILLIAM P. McGRAW, a summons and complaint for the recovery of personal property in specie against said defendant and asks an endorsement by the Clerk of this Court "That the Sheriff is required to take the property mentioned in said complaint into his possession," as required by law in such cases, which summons and complaint are returnable to the next term of the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, and which said endorsement is made upon the plaintiff entereing into this bond.
