# C O U N T O N E.

The plaintiff claims of the defendants the sum of THREE HUNDRED (\$300.00) DOLLARS as damages, for that, heretofore, on to-wit: 22nd day of June, 1954, on U. S. Highway 31, on the north side of the Court House in front of Wilson Chevrolet Building, in Bay Minette, Alabama, the defendant, G. WAYLAND WOODSON who was then and there an agent, servant or employee of the defendants G. WAYLAND WOODSON AND C. S. WOODSON, Individually, and doing business as BALDWIN FURNITURE COMPANY, acting within the line and scope of his employment as such, so negligently operated a pickup truck which he was then and there driving, by suddenly stopping in the middle of the travel portion of U. S.
