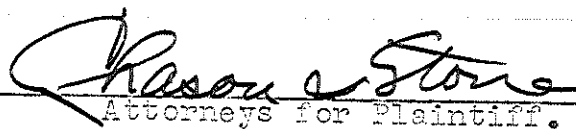

COUNT ONE:
