And in said petition Baldwin County alleges that it is necessary and proper and to the interest of the County of Baldwin, that the county have and own the said lands for the purpose of a right of way for a road and the petitioner desires to have said lands condemned for and as a road for the use of the said County as a right of way for a public road; and praying that this Honorable Court will make an order appointing a day for the hearing of this petition; that due and legal notice of the same be given to Rose Worcester and Olive Worcester, Maude L. 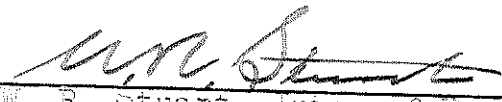
