

TO THE HONORABLE, JOHN D. LEIGH, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT
COURT, BALDWIN COUNTY, ALA.--In equity.

Your Orator, Louis B. Davis, respectfully represents and shows unto your Honor as follows:

1. That he has been a bona fide resident citizen of the County of Baldwin, State of Alabama, for a period of more than the last twelve months, next preceeding the filing of this bill, residing at Rabon, in said County and that he is over the age of twenty-one years.

2. That Lizzie Davis is a non-resident of the State of Alabama, residing at Mariana. Fla., Route TA, Box 50, and is the wife of the said Lous B. Davis.

3. That your Orator and the said Lizzie Davis were lawfully married about June 20th, 1920, and lived together until a short time ago, at which time your Orator discovered that the said Lizzie Davis was pregnant at the time of marriage, and that this was without his knowledge or agency.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS.

The premises considered, your Oratrix respectfully prays that the said Lizzie Davis be made party respondent to this bill of complaint by the usual process of this Honorable Court, and that she be required to demur, plead to or answer the same within the time allowed by law, or that the same be forever confessed.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF.

That upon the final hearing of this cause Your Honor will grant unto your Orator an absolute divorce from the said Lizzie Davis.

That if your Orator is mistken in the relief prayed then Your Honor will grant unto him such other, different and general relief as ~~shaxxxx~~ he may in justice and equity be entitled, he will ever pray.

The Respondent, Lizzie Davis, is required to answer each and every paragraph of the foregoing bill of complaint from 1 to 2, both inclusive, but not under oath, answer under oath being hereby expressly waived.
