When we received your wire of the 17th to proceed as acknowledged we naturally put it in production, but we are getting ahead of the printers today to see just what can be done.

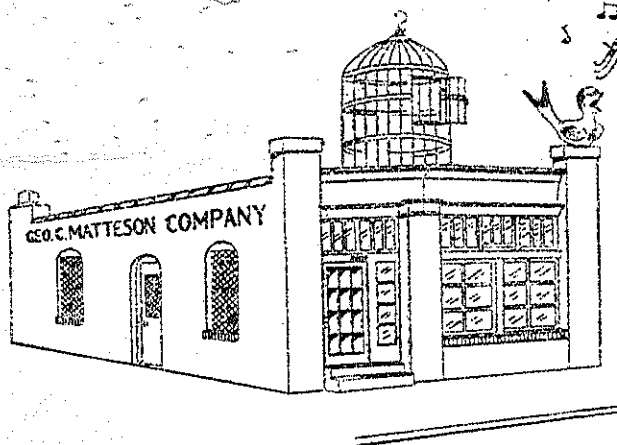
If we can stop the order we will do so, but after it has been in process this long I doubt very much if there will be any chance.

We have your Change of Copy Notice on your order No. 46557 which called for 250 #2000 Clippers for W. A. Thompson at Bay Minette, Alabama.

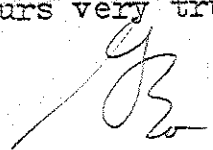
Very sorry to say that the backs of these clippers have already been stamped up and the parts are over at the platers at the present time.

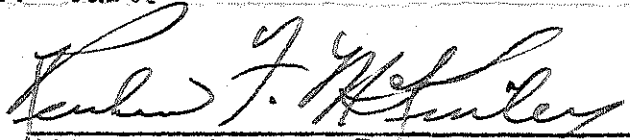
