as Mayor of the said Town of Bay Minette, Alabama, sentenced to \$50.00 fine & \$6.85 Court Cost total \$56.85

And whereas, the said Edward Byars

has this day prayed an appeal from said judgment to the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama.
