TO THE HONORABLE, JOHN D? LEIGH, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT,  
BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA,--In Equity.

Your Oratrix, Hattie Broughton,<sup>Wallace,</sup>/respectfully represents and shows unto Your Honor as follows:

1. That she is a bona fide resident citizen of Baldwin County, and have resided in said County for a period of more than the last three preceeding years next before the filing of this bill, and that she is over the age of twenty-one years.

That Edward Wallace is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, residing at Hurricane, Alabama, and over the age of twenty-one years.

2. That your Oratrix and the said Edward Wallace were lawfully married on or about July 9th, 1919, and lived together as man and wife until about September 28th, 1920, at which time the said Edward Wallace struck me on the arm and told me that if I did not get away from his place he would kill me and said that if he could not kill me any other way he would poison me. At this time he also cursed me and abused me in every way possible. That from the said acts of violence her life and health was in danger and that from his conduct there is reasonable apprehension of such violence./

3. That your Oratrix is an unwell woman and not able to work having had trouble which made an operation necessary and that after the said operation your Oratrix is practically helpless and cannot do any hard work as requested by the said Edward Wallace.

That the said Edawrd Wallace is an able bodied man capable of doing manuel labor and has abgreat deal of real and personal property, valued at several thousand dollars. That the said Edward Wallace is capable of supporting his i wife in a manner suitable to his condition in life.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS.

The premises considered, your Oratrix respectfully prays that the said Edward Wallace be made party respondent to this bill of complaint by the usual process of this Honorable Court, and that he be required to demur, plead to or answer the same within the time and under the penalties as provided by law, or that the same be forever confessed.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF.

That upon the final hearing of this cause Your Honor will grant unto Oratrix an absolute divorce from the said Edward Wallace.

That your Honor will enter a decree, allowing this Complainant alimony pendente lite, reasonable attorneys fee pendente lite, permanent alimony and attorneys fees out of the estate of the said Edward Wallace.

That if your Oratrix is mistaken in the relief prayed then your Honor will grant unto her such other, further, different and general relief as in justice and equity she may be entitled, she will ever pray, etc.
