 To Harry Franklin White, Employee. | IN THE CIRCUIT COURT OF
 Against Swift-Hunter Lumber Company, Employer. | BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA

The undersigned, being the only parties in the above entitled matter, hereby petition the Court for approval of the following agreement and settlement, and agree and represents to the Court as follows:

That they are subject to the provisions of the Workmen's Compensation Law of Alabama. That the said employee, aged 24 years, residing at Stockton, Alabama, who can read and understand the English language, did on the 29th day of October, 1954, on or about 11:30 A. M., sustained an injury by accident while employed by said employer, which injury occurred at Atmore, Alabama, and resulted in permanent partial disability of said employee and consisted of the permanent loss of the first phlange of the left fore finger.

That said employee was receiving, at the time of injury, wages at the rate of \$29.53 per week.

Therefore, it is hereby agreed that the employee is entitled to and shall receive compensation for said injury from the employer beginning October 29, 1954, at the rate of \$16.24 per week during disability for 22 1/2 weeks, the computed value of which at 55% under the Workmen's Compensation Law of The Alabama Code of 1940, Title 26 Section 299, is \$365.40 with \$45.40 having been paid todate leaving a balance of \$320.40 subject to a deduction of 4% for a lump sum settlement leaving a computed total of \$307.56.

The employee acknowledges he has received todate medical and surgical treatment and benefits given by said act.

This settlement contains the whole agreement between the parties hereto.
