The condition of the above obligation is such, that,

whereas, the above bounden Elmer A. Cooper was, on the 13 day of Dec., 1954, Convicted in the Municipal Court of said Town of Elberta, of the

offense of D.W.I., and by the judgement of said Court sentenced to th paymenet of a fine of \$108.50 dollars.

And, whereas, the said Elmer A. Cooper has this day prayed on appeal from said

judgement to the Circuit Court of said County.

Now, if the said Elmer A. Cooper shall appear at the next term of the Circuit Court,

and from term to term thereafter until discharged, and abide by and perform whatever sentence may be adjudged in said Court against him, then the above obligation ~~IS VOID~~ to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect; and each of us to waive our ~~exemptions~~ <sup>exemptions</sup> as to personal property.
