To any Sheriff of the State of Alabama, Greeting:

WHEREAS, at a regular November Term, 1955, of the Circuit Court of Baldwin County,  
to-wit: On the 17th day of November, 1955, being a regular day of  
said term, Robert J. Meszaros

recovered judgment against William E. Bozeman

for the sum of Six Hundred and 00/100 (\$600.00) Dollars, and cost of suit,  
and affidavit having been made by Norborne C. Stone, Jr.  
that process of garnishment is believed to be necessary to obtain satisfaction of such Judgment, and that the  
following named persons or corporations, viz:

The State of Alabama

has or is believed to have in its possession, or under its control money  
or effects belonging to said defendant or that it is, or  
is believed to be indebted to said defendant or to be liable to them, or to one of them on a  
contract for the delivery of personal property, or on a contract for the payment of money which may be  
discharged by the delivery of personal property, or which is payable in personal property.

You Are Therefore Hereby Commanded to Summon The State of Alabama by  
service of this Writ upon John Graves, as Comptroller of The State  
of Alabama (the person authorized by law to draw the warrant on  
the treasury of said government or to issue a check for salary due)

to be and appear before the honorable Judge of the Circuit Court for Baldwin County, at the Court House  
thereof, in the city of Bay Minette, on the 4th Monday in April A. D. 1958,  
then and there within the three first days of the term, to answer on oath, whether at the time of the service  
of the garnishment, or at the time making its answer, or at any time intervening the time of serv-  
ing the garnishment, and making the answer it was indebted to said defendant  
and whether it will not be indebted in future to said defendant  
by a contract then existing, and whether by a contract then existing it  
is, or are, liable to said defendants for the delivery of personal property, or for the payment of money which  
may be discharged by the delivery of personal property, or which is payable in personal property, and  
whether it has not in its possession or under its control money or  
effects belonging to the defendant William E. Bozeman

Herein fail not, and have you then and there this Writ.



That his name is Norborne C. Stone, Jr and that he is one of the attorneys of record for the Plaintiff in that certain cause entitled Robert J. Meszaros, Plaintiff, vs. William E. Bozeman, Defendant and numbered 2506 on the docket of the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama. That on November 17, 1955 the Plaintiff, Robert J. Meszaros, recovered a judgment against the Defendant, William E. Bozeman, for the sum of Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), together with the cost of said suit; and that said judgment remains wholly unsatisfied and in full force and effect.
