Propst, a Justice of the Peace in and for said County, rendered a judgment in favor of the said Ruby Adams, administratrix of estate of Mattie Adams, deceased, against the said Erin Dean, for the sum of \$60.00, debt, and \$ 5.10, costs, for which judgment the said Erin Dean, has prayed for and obtained an appeal to the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama; if the said Erin Dean shall prosecute said appeal to effect, or if she fail in said appeal, shall pay such judgment, both as to debt and costs, as may be rendered against her by the said Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, then in either of said events, this obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
