Comes the defendant, J. L. RUPLE, and for answer and plea to the complaint and to each count thereof, separately and severally, says:

1. Defendant disclaims possession of any portion of said lands except as lies east of Bayou Wiltz. Specifically, the defendant claims to own, and admits possession of, the following described lands in Baldwin County, Alabama, viz:

All Section 40, Township 3 South, Range 2 East; East of Bayou Wiltz.

- 2. As to the remainder of said lands the defendant pleads not guilty.
- 3. Defendant suggests upon the record that he and those whose possession he has have been in possession of said lands for more than three years next preceding the filing of the complaint in this cause, under a claim of ownership and color of title, and have placed permanent improvements thereon, consisting of, to-wit: the planting of young pine trees and construction and maintenance of fire lines, and asks that the Court ascertain the value of said permanent improvements placed on the land as required by law.
