

COUNT I

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS AND TWENTY-SIX CENTS (\$450.26) due by promissory note made by him on, to-wit, the 17th day of September, 1954, and payable on, to-wit, the 21st day of April, 1955, with interest thereon at the rate of six percent per annum from, to-wit, the 21st day of April, 1955, and the Plaintiff avers that in said note and as part of the consideration thereof the Defendant agreed to and did waive all his rights of exemption as to personal property, and further agreed to pay a reasonable attorney's fee for the collection of said note, which the Plaintiff hereby claims in the sum of NINETY DOLLARS (\$90.00).
