

COUNT ONE

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of Twenty Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$20,000.00) as damages for that heretofore and on to-wit: the 13th day of October, 1954, the Defendant so negligently operated the motor vehicle which he was driving Southwardly on an unnamed street at its intersection with U. S. Highway 90 within the limits of the town of Loxley, Alabama, which said Highway at said point is a public highway in the County of Baldwin, State of Alabama, so as to cause or allow the same to run into, upon or against the automobile which the Plaintiff was then and there driving Eastwardly on U. S. Highway 90 at said time and place, and as a direct and proximate result of said negligence the Plaintiff sustained serious, permanent personal injuries, including multiple severe contusions of the head, chest, hip and about the knees and cerebral concussions and broken ribs; and was made sick and sore and caused to spend great sums for doctor bills and other medical bills in and about the treatment of her injuries, hence this suit.
