THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That, whereas, the above bounden James M Amos

was on the 27 day of June, 1935, convicted in the Mayor's Court of Bay Minette, Alabama, of the offense of Driving Automobile on the Streets of Bay Minette, Bay Minette, Ala, while Intoxicated.

and by Judgment of Julian Bristow

as Mayor of the said Town of Bay Minette, Alabama, sentenced to \$100.00 fine and cost \$6.85 Total \$106.85

And whereas, the said James M. Amos

has this day prayed an appeal from said judgment to the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama.

Now, if the said James M Amos

shall appear at the next term of the said Circuit Court and from term to term thereafter until discharged, and abide by and perform whatever sentence may be adjudged in said court against him, then the above obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
