



Dyas, in Baldwin County, Alabama, I am well acquainted with the Complainant and the defendant, and have known them both about 15 years, living as a neighbor to them during the time I have known them.  I know that the Complainant was in every respect a good well
wou ld often leave her said husband and infant children to go with other men. In january, 1919, she left her husband and children and
went to Mississippi with another man and did not return until in October, 1919, at which time the complainant refused to live with her
longer on account of her adulterous conduct, and they have not lived together as man and wife since that date. In July 1920, she gate birth to another child. At numerous times before the seperation of Complainant and defendant and while her husband was off at work defe -ant would have James Cravey and other men of sporty reputations com to her house of two small rooms and they would remain for an hour or more at a time. On the occassion of such visits from men she would
put the children out of the house and close the doors. From the evid -dences I have known and seen and in her every day life and general conduct. I know that defendant is not a virtuous woman
and she has been guilty of adultery with said James Cravey and other men. Jim Cravey is a married man and visits Clara Brown constantly and she puts the children out of doors and closes the room so that it will be dark.

Robert Brown , witness for complainant who being duly sworn testified as follows: My name is Robert Brown, I am the complainant in this cause, I am 26v years of age I was married to defendant Clara Brown at Dyas, Baldwin County, Alabama, in Febuary, 1912, fr om said date until October 1919, and have not lived together as man and wife since that date after I had learned that she was living in adultery with one James Cravey, a married man. At said date in Oct 1919, she returned to Baldwin County, Alabama, after being in the State of Mississippi for a period of over nine months, where she went with another man whose name is John Faulk, against my consent. For the past year or more she has lived alone in a small house of two rroms near Dyas, Alabama, where she was frequently visited during the day and night by said Cravey. For several months last past she has occupied said two rooms house with a man whose name is unknown to me. Jim Cravey stays with her-alen Clara Brown as much or more than one half of his time He is there until late at night and the room is dark. Raplet Bernus
