Count I.

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant, ONE HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE DOLLARS AND FORTY-SIX CENTS (\$175.46), due from him by account, on, to-wit, the 13th day of June, 1955, which sum of money, with interest thereon is still unpaid.

Count II.

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant FIFTY-FIVE DOLLARS AND EIGHTEEN CENTS (\$55.18), due from him by account between the Defendant and Fairhope Hardware and Supply Company on, to-wit, the 12th day of August, 1954, which sum of money, with the interest thereon is still unpaid and is the property of the Plaintiff.

Count III.

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant THREE HUNDRED AND SIXTEEN DOLLARS (\$316.00), due by promissory note made by the Defendant on, to-wit, the 7th day of June, 1954, and payable in monthly installments of FORTY DOLLARS (\$40.00) per month, and the Plaintiff further alleges that the Defendant is in default of said payments in the sum of THREE HUNDRED AND SIXTEEN DOLLARS (\$316.00), being the installments falling due after the 6th day of July, 1955.
