

The plaintiff claims of the defendant the sum of Ten Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$10,000.00) as damages for that heretofore and on, to-wit, the 2nd day of February, 1954, the defendant so negligently operated a motor vehicle which he was driving westwardly on U. S. Highway 90 at a point, to-wit, 8.4 miles east of Robertsedale, which said highway at said point is a public highway in Baldwin County, Alabama, as to cause or allow the same to run into, upon or against the vehicle of the plaintiff which was then and there being driven eastwardly on said highway at said time and place, and as a direct and proximate result of said negligence the plaintiff's vehicle was badly bent and damaged, which damage included a badly bent frame, severædamage to cab, panel, fender, bumper, grill, radiator, fan, front springs, right front headlight, drive line, compression shaft, saddle tank, tires, steering assembly, and plaintiff lost the use of said vehicle for a long period of time; hence this suit.
