Dear Mr. Richerson:-

While clearing off my desk this morning I came across the enclosed papers which I presume must have been left out of some case which I had already disposed of, so I am sending to you in order that you may place them in the files.

In the matter of Mrs. Hulda M. Lawrence, I have carefully gone over the papers and I really think that they are in proper shape, and that it will take no further order of the court to dissolve the corporation, Mrs. Lawrence having turned over all books, returned checks which were mailed out to stock holders and complied with the order of the court. I really think this discharges her without an additional order. The only thing required of you would be to preserve the books of the corporation and to pay the money to the parties entitled to the same. As to those whose addresses you are unable to ascertain, you should hold their money and whenever their addresses are ascertained turn the money over to them, and that will finally close up the matter. Probably after this is done a decree can be prepared which will discharge you from further liability in the matter.


