Count One

The plaintiff claims of the defendant the sum of \$7000.00 as damages for that heretofore to-wit: January 4, 1955, the plaintiff was riding in an automobile on public Highway State number Three, one-half a mile North of the City limits of Foley in Baldwin County, Alabama, where she had a right to be, when the defendant negligently ran an automobile into, upon or against the automobile in which the plaintiff was riding, and by reason thereof and as a proximate results and consequence thereof the plaintiff was severely injured in this to-wit: she was made sick, sore and lame, she suffered multiple contusions of the arms, legs and body; her hip was fractured; she suffered acute shock; she suffered and continues to suffer great physical pain and mental anguish; she was internally injured; she was permanently injured; she was rendered less able to perform her work and labors which condition continues to exist and will so continue to exist for an indeterminate period of time; and the plaintiff avers that by reason of said injuries which she sustained in said collision she was compelled to go to a hospital, employ surgeons and doctors at great expense which said employment now continues as to treatment by surgeons and doctors and which expenses continues in an amount not known by your plaintiff; and plaintiff further alleges that by reason of the negligence complained of on the part of the defendant and as a proximate result and consequence thereof, the plaintiff's automobile was demolished or greatly damaged and rendered less valuable and the plaintiff claims of the defendant damages for all of the above as aforesaid.
