
C O M P L A I N T

COUNT ONE

The Plaintiffs claim of the Defendant, Providence Washington Insurance Company, a Corporation, the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2000.00), the value of a dwelling house which the Defendant, on the 16th day of February, 1955, insured against loss or injury by fire and other perils in the policy of insurance mentioned, for the term of one years, which house was wholly destroyed by fire on the 28th day of December, 1955 of which the Defendant has had notice.

COUNT TWO

The Plaintiffs claim of the Defendant, Queen Insurance Company of New York, a Corporation, the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00), the value of a dwelling house which the Defendant, on the 4th day of November, 1955, insured against loss or injury by fire and other perils in the policy of insurance mentioned, for the term of one years, which house was wholly destroyed by fire on the 28th day of December, 1955, of which the Defendant has had notice.
