Mrs. Pearl "aldroup being duly sworn deposes and says:-

My name is Peatl Waldroup, and at the time of the filing of the bill of complaint in this cause, I was a resident of Daphne, Ala.

I am now living at Mobile Alabama, I have heen a bon afide resident

of the State of Alabama, for more than one year next preceding the filing of this bill of complaint, Frank H Waldrop and I were marr ied on the 7th day of eptember, 1918.atiq Pontotoc County, Miss, I aml9 years of age and Frank Waldrop is about 25 years of age, and he is a non resident of the State of Alabama, but I do not know where he resides. I lived with the defendant in Pontotoc County Miss from the time we were married until the 11th day of May 1919 On the 10th day of May, 1919, the defendant struck me with a stick across the shoulder twice. and said that he would cripple me for life if I did not leave him, Iwalked out on the porch and he shoved the door to, and said he did not want to see me again as long as he lived. Sveral times previous to this he slapped me, He said that he only married me to keep from being drafted for the War and that he never did love me. I was in great danger of actual violence on my person, and with danger to my life and health, and on account of my fear for my life and health and the further fact that he nailed up the house and shut me out of the house I could not live with him.as his wife I was left penniless. by the defendant and was complled to return to my fathers home, Since this time I have never heard from the defendant and do not know 70% Where he lives. Now. The seperation from the defendant was in no way capsed by me for I was always a true and faithful wife to him and he had no cause whatever to treat me in such a er cruel manner.

Pearl Waldrop-

G.I.Griifin a witness for Complainant who being duly sworn testified as follows: My name is G?1. Griffin, I reside at Mobile Alabama, I am the father of Pearl Waldrop the Complainant, Pearl Waldrop is 19 years of age, and she had resdieed in the State of Alabama, one year next preceding filing of this Bill, I do not know of my personal knowledge of Defendants cruel treatment of my daughter, but several parties told me that he was very cruel to her, and if they wre in my place they would not let her live with him any longer . Also my daughter Pearl Waldrop told me that he was crule to her and that he had threatened her life and had hit her several times with a stick, that he had shut her out of their home and would not let her return and I knew from what I had heard that living with him would cause great danger to her health and life .Since the seperation May 1919, Pearl Waldrop has lived with me , and we have never heard any more from Frank Waldrop, and do not know his present address.

DIRECTIONS FOR EXAMINATION OF WITNESSES UPON INTERROGATORIES.
1. If the time and place of executing the Commission are named therein, or in a notice appended thereto, the testimony must be taken at the time and place designated; if no time and place are designated, the Commissioners will call the witness before them at such time and place as they may appoint, and administer to him an oath to speak the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, in answer to the interrogatories to be propounded to him. The time and place of examining witnesses should be stated in the caption of the deposition. 2. The caption and deposition should be as follows:

To the second direct interrogatory he saith: (Write the answer to this interrogatory, and all others, as directed above). If there are cross or rebutting interrogatories, go through with them in the same manner, thus:
To the first cross interrogatory he saith, etc. To the second cross interrogatory he saith, etc.
To the first rebutting interrogatory he saith, etc.
Neither party should be permitted to put to the witness, during his examination, any **erbal question or suggestion; and if anything of the kind is done by either party, the Commissioner should write it down in the deposition just as it occurred. The testimony may be written down by any one or more of the Commissioners, by the witness himself, or by any disinterested third party in the presence of the Commissioners, and be read over to the witness if he desire it, and must be subscribed by him.
3. The Commissioners must then add their certificate, as follows: We, (or I, if only one acts), the undersigned, Commissioners in said commission named, hereby certify that we are not of
counsel or of kin to any of the parties to this cause, nor in any manner interested in the result thereof; that we are personally acquainted with said witness, J——K——, and know him to be the identical person named in said commission (or have had proof made before us of the personal identity of the witness, and that he is the identical person named in said commission); that he was sworn and examined as above stated; and that his evidence was taken down, as near as might be, in his own language, and was sub-
scribed by him in our presence on theday of19, at the place above stated.

If the witness claims for his attendance, the Commissioners should state in their certificate the number of miles traveled, the number of days the witness attended, ferriage paid, if any, etc. 4. If any exhibits, writings, or papers are produced and used as evidence by the witness, they shall be annexed to the deposi-
tion to which they relate, and shall be identified by suitable letters or marks. If the testimony cannot be taken in one day, the Commissioners, noting the same, may continue from day to day until com-
