

- That on or about, to-wit: July 250, 1921, in Bald-win County, Alabama, the said Holman Johns, did permit or allow some to have, possess, operate or locate om his premise, an apparatus, plant or structure for the distilling, making or manufacturing of prohibited liquors or beverages; and that the said Holman Johns is the owner of the said premises upon which was located the apparatus, plant or structure for distilling, making or manuafacturing prohibited liquors which is hereinafter described.
- 4. That on or about the said date, July 256, 1921, the said Holman Johns did distill, make or manufacture, alcoholic, spirituous, vinous or malt liquors on the following described premise, to-wit:
