


SUMMONS

COUNT I

The Plaintiff claims of the defendant SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY-SEVEN & 73/100 DOLLARS (\$727.73) for breach of the condition of a bond made by the defendant, as principal, and the Plaintiff, as surety, and which bond was breached by the said Defendant as principal, and which required the Plaintiff as surety to pay an account to Hill Soberg Co., Mobile, Alabama, on, to wit: the 9th day of March 1955.

And the Plaintiff says that the condition of said bond has been broken by the Defendant in this, that the Defendant failed to pay the balance due for materials supplied the Defendant, d/b/a Ingram Electric Company, subcontractor of R. A. Jensen Rehabilitation of Hanger No. 1221, N.A.A.S. Barin Field, Foley, Alabama, to the damage of the Plaintiff, as above stated.

COUNT II

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY-SEVEN & 73/100 DOLLARS (\$727.73), due from him for money paid by the Plaintiff for the Defendant on the 9th day of March, 1955, which sum of money with interest thereon is still unpaid.

There is attached to the original claim an itemized statement of account, sworn to before an officer of the Plaintiff showing the statement of this account as of the 21st day of June, 1956.

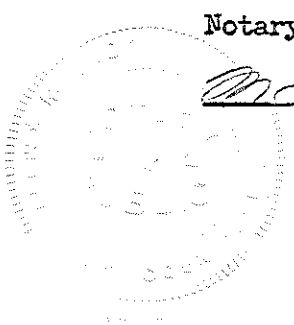
