ONE:

TWO:

That the Respondent, ARTHUR PROSSER, is over twenty-

THREE:

Your Complainant alleges that he is in the quiet and
peaceable possession of certain lands in Baldwin County, Alabama,
claiming to own the same in fee simple, said lands being described
as follows, to-wit:

Complainant further alleges that the Respondent, ARTHUR

Complainant further alleges that no suit is pending to

Complainant further prays that upon the hearing of this cause, this Honorable Court establish the title of Complainant in and to the lands herein described and further find and decree that the said ARTHUR PROSSER has no claim, right, title, or interest in, or encumbrance upon the said lands herein described or any part hereof, and grant unto your Complainant such other, further, different or general relief as he may be in equity and good conscience entitle to receive and as in duty bound he will
