Complainant further alleges that no suit is pending to question and test the validity of such claim, right, title, or interest in, or encumbrance of the said Respondent, and the Complainant therefore calls upon the Respondent, ARTHUR PROSSER, to

set forth and specify his right, title, or interest in, or encumbrance upon said lands, and to show how and what instrument the same is derived and/or created.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS:

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, the Complainant prays that your Honor will take jurisdiction of this cause made by this Bill of Complaint, and by appropriate process make the said ARTHUR PROSSER, Respondent to this Bill of Complaint, requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties presecribed by law and the practice of this honorable Court.

Complainant further prays that upon the hearing of this cause, this Honorable Court establish the title of Complainant in and to the lands herein described and further find and decree that the said ARTHUR PROSSER has no claim, right, title, or interest in, or encumbrance upon the said lands herein described or any part hereof, and grant unto your Complainant such other, further, different or general relief as he may be in equity and good conscience entitle to receive and as in duty bound he will
