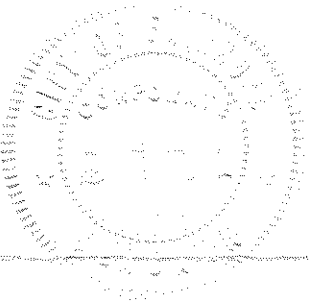

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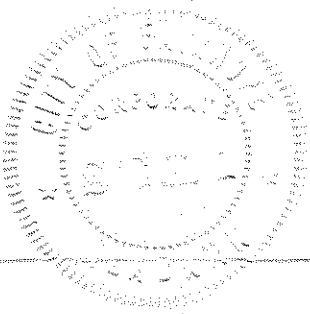
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# APPEAL BOND

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we Walter James Rayborn  
as principal, and W F Walker and Ruby Rayborn and  
as sureties are held and firmly bound unto the Town  
of Fairhope in the sum of Three Hundred Dollars, for the payment of which well  
and truly to be made to the Town of Fairhope, we do hereby bind ourselves, and our heirs and assigns,  
jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

Sealed with our seals and dated the 22nd day of Dec. in the year of our  
Lord, one thousand nine hundred and 56

The Condition of this Obligation is such, That whereas the above bounden Walter James Rayborn  
has on the day of the date of these presents claimed  
an APPEAL to the Circuit Court, next to be held in and for the County of Baldwin, in the State afore-  
said, at the next Term thereof, from a judgment rendered on the 22 day of Dec 19 56  
by C. D. SNOW Esq., Recorder of the Town of Fairhope and Ex-officio  
Justice of the Peace, in and for said Town, against said Walter James Rayborn  
requiring him to pay said Town of Fairhope Three Hundred Dollars,  
as a fine, or Struggle disorderly and resisting arrest  
NOW if the said Walter James Rayborn shall appear at said term of  
said Circuit Court, and from term to term thereafter until discharged by due process of law, then this  
obligation to be void, otherwise to remain of full force and effect.
