TO THE HONORABLE F. W. HARE, JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Your petitioner, Herman A. Ulitzsch, respectfully represents unto your Honor as follows:

FIRST: That both he and his former wife, Anna Ulitzsch, are over the age of 21 years and that he is a resident of *Logan's* County, Illinois, where he has continuously resided for a number of years.

SECOND: That on the 14th day of July, 1924, said Anna Ulitzsch obtained a divorce in this Court whereby the bonds of matrimony existing between herself and petitioner were dissolved and annuled and whereby she was divorced from your petitioner; that under said decree the said Anna Ulitzsch was permitted to again contract a marriage, but that no order was made in same either allowing or disallowing petitioner to re-marry, and more than sixty days has elapsed since the rendition of said decree.




