

PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF LUMP SUM SETTLEMENT
UNDER PROVISIONS OF TITLE 26, SECTION 299 OF
THE 1940 CODE OF ALABAMA

The undersigned being the only parties interested in the above entitled matter, hereby petition the Court for approval of the following agreement and settlement and agree and represent unto the Court as follows:

1. That they are subject to the Workmans Compensation Law of Alabama. That the said employee, who is over twenty-one years of age and resides in Escambia County, Alabama, and who can read, write and understand the English language, did, on to-wit, the 11th day of October, 1956, sustain an injury by accident while employed by the said employer, which injury occurred at Bay Minette, Alabama, and was an injury to the said employee's finger.

2. Because of injuries to the employee's back which had been previously sustained by him while he was not employed by the said employer, the said employee has been caused to incur expenses for treatments of his said back injuries, liability for all of which is denied by the employer because the said injuries were not received by the employee while he was employed by the said employer.

3. The said employee was receiving at the time of said injury to his finger, which occurred on October 11, 1956, an average of \$35.23 per week.

4. It is agreed between the said employee and the said employer that the employer will pay to the employee, the sum of Three Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$300.00) and will pay all of the costs incurred in this proceeding in full compromise settlement for any and all claims or claims which the said employee has against the said employer for all said injuries to this date. The

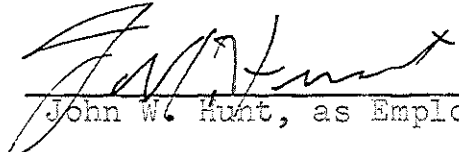
employee agrees to give the employer a receipt for the said payment of \$300.00 which is to be made as provided herein when this settlement is approved by the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama.

5. The employee acknowledges that he has received to date all medical and surgical treatments and benefits given by the said Act because of the said injury to the employee's finger.

6. This settlement contains the whole agreement between the said parties hereto.

WHEREFORE, the said employee and the said employer petition the Court to approve this lump sum settlement.

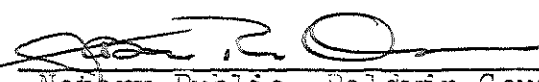

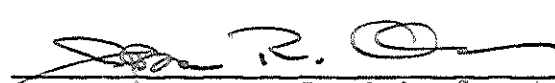
