

SETTLEMENT AND PETITION

In the matter of compensation for injury	I	IN THE CIRCUIT COURT OF

The undersigned being the only parties in the above entitled matter, hereby petition the court for approval of the following agreement and settlement, and agree and represent to the court as follows:

That they are subject to the provisions of the Workman's Compensation Law of Alabama. That said employee, age twenty-one years, residing at Daphne, Alabama, who can read and understand the English language, did on the 26th day of June, 1956, sustain an injury by accident while employed by said employer, which injury occurred at Montrose, Alabama, and resulted in permanent, partial disability of said employee which consisted of fifty percent (50%) permanent partial loss of use of his left hand, losing his third, fourth and fifth fingers on such hand.

That said employee was receiving at the time of his injury, wages at the rate of forty dollars and sixty-four cent (\$40.64) per week.

THEREFORE it is hereby agreed that the employee is entitled to and shall receive compensation for said injury from the employer for seventy-five (75) weeks, at twenty-six dollars forty-two cent (26.42) a week payable as follows: Thirty-four weeks has been paid to date leaving a balance of forty-one weeks still due. The commuted value of forty-one weeks at twenty-six dollars forty-two cent (\$26.42) a week under the Workman's Compensation Law of Alabama is one thousand sixty-six dollars and thirty cent (\$1,066.30). Which amount the employee has agreed to accept in full settlement of all amounts due him and which amount the employer is now ready to pay, subject to the approval of this court.

This settlement contains the whole agreement between the parties hereto. Upon the court approving the lump settlement as hereinabove set out and upon payment of such amount by the employer

to the employee, such employer and his bondsman shall be discharged of all liability.
