AMENDED BILL.

Comes the Complainant, C. A. Thompson, and amends the original Bill of Complaint heretofore filed in this cause in the following particulars: The Complainant amends the said Bill of Complaint by adding after paragraph 4 of the said original Bill paragraphs 5, 6 and 7 which read as follows:

5. Your Orator further shows that the Respondent, A. F. Trawick, has since the commencement of this suit and the service of process upon him in this said cause, gone upon the property described in the original Bill, namely, the West Half of the Southeast Quarter and the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 4, Township 4 South Range 4 East in Baldwin County, Alabama, and has and is now cupping the timber on the said property for turpentine purposes which will materially reduce the value of the said timber growing upon the said land, which constitutes practically all of its value, and will permanently injure it.

6. Your Orator has not given the said Respondent, A. F. Trawick, or any other person working for or under him, permission to go upon the said land or any part of it and in any way work or interfere with the land or the timber growing thereon.

7. Your Orator is informed and believes and on such information and belief states the fact to be that the said A. F. Trawick is not financially able to pay and satisfy a judgment which may be rendered against him for any damages done to the said land or timber; that if the said land or timber growing thereon is injured by the said A. F. Trawick or those claiming or working under

him your Orator will be irreparably injured; that he has no adequate remedy at law and that it is necessary that the said Respondent, A. F. Trawick, his agents, servants and employees be enjoined from working the timber on the said land, trespassing on or in any way disturbing the status quo of the said property.

Your Orator further amends his original Bill of Complaint by adding after the words "holds no encumbrance upon the same" in the first paragraph of the Prayer for Relief, the following:

Your Orator prays that pending a final hearing and determination of the issues of this suit your Honor will cause to be issued a temporary writ of injunction or restraining order according to the rules and practices of this Honorable Court, restraining and enjoining the Respondent, A. F. Trawick, his agents, servants and employees from turpentineing the timber on the lands hereinabove described, trespassing on the said lands and from doing anything or taking any action which would disturb the status quo of the said property.

Your Orator further amends the Foot Note in the original Bill by changing the figure "4" where the same therein appears so that the same will read "7".

In this cause it appearing from an Affidavit of the Complainant, C. A. Thompson, that the Respondent, Mrs. William H. Bennett, is over the age of twenty-one years and a non-resident of the State of Alabama, whose residence and post office address is unknown and cannot be ascertained after reasonable effort.

It is therefore ordered that the said Respondent plead, answer or demur to the allegations of the Bill of Complaint filed against her in this cause before the 2nd day of January, 1934, or upon the expiration of thirty days from the said date the same will be taken as confessed against her.

It is further ordered that a copy of this Order be published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the Baldwin Times, a newspaper published in Bay Minette, Baldwin County, Alabama, and that a copy thereof be posted at the front door of the Court House of said County immediately after the issuance hereof.
