Comes now the Plaintiff in the above styled cause, by his attorneys, and moves this Honorable Court to enter a judgment by default against the Defendant and in favor of the Plaintiff for the amount sued for in the complaint and the costs in this cause expended and as grounds therefor says as follows:

1. That this suit was begun by attachment on April 24, 1957, and the Summons and Complaint were filed on that date. That on said date the Clerk of this Court issued a Writ of Attachment and on the 23rd day of May, 1957, the Sheriff of Baldwin County, Alabama, levied on certain personal property belonging to the Defendant as shown by his return in this cause. That thereafter on the 16th day of July, 1957, an attachment notice was issued by the Clerk of this Court and the same was published once a week for three consecutive weeks in the Baldwin Times, a newspaper of general circulation published in Bay Minette, Baldwin County, Alabama, in the issues of said newspaper dated July 25th, August 1st and August 8th, 1957. That more than thirty (30) days have elapsed since the date of the last publication hereinabove referred to and the Defendant has failed to plead, answer or demur to the Bill of Complaint.
