The plaintiff claims of the defendants Two Hundred Ninety-Five & NO/100 (\$295.00) Dollars, due by promissory note made by the defendant, Gulf States Development Company, a corporation, and endorsed by the defendant, Thomas A. Smith, both on the 22nd day of June, 1957, and payable on the 22nd day of July, 1957, with interest thereon at eight (8%) per cent. per annum from maturity.

The plaintiff further avers that in and by the terms of said note the defendants waived as to said debt all right to exemption under the Constitution and Laws of Alabama, and plaintiff claims benefit of said waiver. Plaintiff further avers that in and by the terms of said note the defendants agreed to pay all costs of collecting said note, including a reasonable attorney's fee, and plaintiff claims of the defendant the further sum of Fifty-Nine & NO/100 (\$59.00) Dollars as such reasonable attorney's fee.
