BILL FOR DIVORCE.

TO THE HONORABLE F. W. HARE, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, IN EQUITY SITTING:

Comes your Complainant, CAESAR WEBB, and, humbly complaining against the Respondent, ROSA ROACH WEBB, respectfully represents and shows unto your Honor the following facts as the basis for the relief hereinafter prayed:

- 1. That both your Complainant and the Respondent are over the age of twenty-one years; that both are residents of Bay Minette, Baldwin County, Alabama, and have been for more than three years next preceding the filing of this Bill of Complaint; that your Complainant and the Respondent are husband and wife, having intermarried at Letohatchee, Alabama, on, to-wit: the 31st day of October, 1921.
- 2. That your Complainant and the Respondent lived together as man and wife at Bay Minette, Baldwin County, Alabama, until, to-wit, July 15, 1934; that, on, to-wit, the 15th day of July, 1934, the Respondent voluntarily abandoned your Complainant and has refused to live with him as his wife since that time, and that the said abandonment has been continuous for a period of more than two years next preceding the filing of this Bill of Complaint.
- 3. That the said Abandonment was without cause, fault or consent on the part of your Complainant.

THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, your Complainant prays this Honorable Court will take jurisdiction of the cause made by this Bill of Complaint, and that the said ROSA ROACH WEBB be made a party defendant hereto, and by proper process be made to plead, answer or demur to this Bill of Complaint within the time and un-

der the pains and penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, your Complainant further prays that upon a hearing or submission of this cause, a Decree may be rendered in his favor forever divorcing him from the said ROSA ROACH WEBE, and that the bonds of matrimony between himself and the Respondent be dissolved, and that your Honor decree to your Complainant the right to remarry, should he so desire; and if your Complainant has not asked for the proper relief, the premises considered, he prays that the Honorable Court may grant him such further, additional and different relief as to your Honor may seem meet, just and proper in Equity, and your Complainant will ever pray, Etc.
