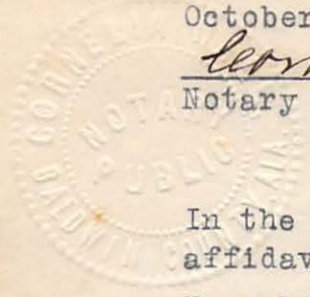





This cause coming on to be heard on this the 20th day of December, 1921, having been submitted for decree on the petition and ex parte affidavits of Loren O. Powers and Jerry Resmondo, thereupon, upon consideration thereof, it is ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that Sophrona Resmondo, a minor, who is over the age of eighteen years, be, and she is relieved of the disabilities of non-age, and she is vested with power to sue and be sued, contract and be contracted with, to receive and take possession of any real and personal property to which she is entitled; to purchase real or personal estate, to sell and to convey real estate and to do all things, and to all intents and purposes as effectually as if she were twenty-one years of age.
