COUNT ONE:

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of Two Hundred Forty-four and 68/100 Dollars (\$244.68) due by Promissory Note made by him on the 4th day of August, 1954, and payable on April 4, 1955, which sum of money is still unpaid.

The Plaintiff alleges that in and by the terms of said note the Defendant agreed to pay all costs of collecting or securing or attemptation to collect or secure said note, including a reasonable attorney's fee, whether the same be collected or secured by suit or otherwise and the Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the additional and further sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) as a reasonable attorney's fee.

The Plaintiff further alleges that the Defendant in and by the terms of said note waived as to the debt evidenced thereby, or any renewal thereof, all rights of exemption under the Constitution and Laws of Alabama as to personal property, and the Plaintiff claims the

benefit of such waiver.
