On November 29, 1957, at approximately 1:00 9 clock P. M., Joseph C. Phillippi was driving the 1957 Buick Convertible, which was owned by Alnita Tillman, Northward on Highway No. 98, leading from Fairhope, Baldwin County, Alabama, toward Daphne, Spanish Fort and Mobile. This is a public highway in Baldwin County, Alabama. Alnita Tillman was a passenger in this said automobile, and Joseph C. Phillippi was acting as her agent. servant or employee, and the operation of the automobile was therefore under her direction and control. At a point approximately 300 feet North of Sea Cliff Drive, at which location there is a curve in U. S. Johnnie Smith Adams is his mother, and was granted complete custody of Andrew Thomas Smith at the time of divorce from his father. The three broken teeth have been capped or replaced and other than for scars, Andrew Thomas Smith has fully

recovered from his injuries.
